



## Martin Luther King Jr. At Home Lesson

In observance of MLK Jr. Day, the DHM has put together this packet containing a lesson inspired by Dr King's teachings which aims to teach children the history, significance, and ongoing relevance of Dr. King and the Civil Rights Movement.

To begin the lesson, have your child complete the first two sections of the K-W-L chart on what they know about MLK Jr, and what they want to know about him. This will give you a better understanding of your child's base knowledge, and allow you to choose resources that will help them discover what they want to know about Dr. King.

After completing the first two sections of their K-W-L chart, we recommend watching some of the selected videos from our Virtual Resource List with your child. Afterward, help your child complete the writing prompts on the following pages and use them as a springboard to discuss MLK Jr.'s legacy.

For the final step in this lesson, have your child complete the Learned section of their K-W-L chart. Discuss what new information they have learned about Dr. King during this lesson, and what ways they can change the world like he did!
